Our Broadcasts Both Sonrise and our Cable Broadcasts are made possible this morning by Faith's LWML and the Erbe family.

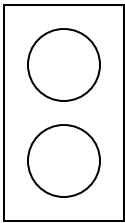

October 2, 2011 – Kids Crossing finds Simon and Bernice discussing the mustard seed and its relationship to faith. The featured speaker is Rev. Jerad Nies Pastor from St. John Lutheran Church in Gregory. The sermon theme is "Good for ... Everything." The hymns are Take My Life and Let It Be; For the Fruit of His Creation; and God Loved the World So That He Gave. The Main Street Living Choir will provide the hymns. The program is interpreted for the hearing impaired.

October 9, 2011 – Kid's Crossing uses drama to illustrate the healing of the ten lepers. The featured speaker is Rev. Karl Gregory from Bethesda Lutheran Church in Marion, SD and First English Lutheran, Parker, SD. The sermon theme is "What is More Powerful Than the Word of God?" The hymns are If Thou But Trust in God to Guide Thee; Blessed Jesus at Thy Word; and Praise God From Whom all Blessings Flow. The Main Street Living Choir will provide the hymns. The program is interpreted for the hearing impaired.
