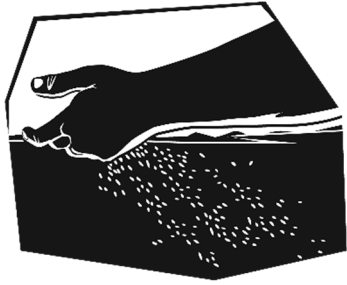


ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR JUNE 14 – THE SECOND SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST


