

BUILDING NEWS

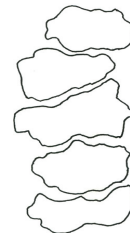
Thank you for your continued gifts to our Building Fund – We thank you for your gifts last Sunday to the Building Fund of \$960.00. The gifts were designated as follows:
