

ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE DAY

- L Today is Easter Sunday, the queen of feasts! On this day we recall how our Lord rose from the dead to proclaim new life to all sinners captive to death and the grave. As the first visitors to the tomb heard: Christ is not here; He is risen. Today we meet our risen Lord where He promised to be—in Word and Sacrament—until we pass through death to our own joyful resurrection in Him. In the First Reading, Peter observes how God the Father approved of

Jesus' sacrifice as evidenced by the fact that He raised Him from the dead and that all who believe in Jesus will be forgiven. In the Epistle, Paul urges believers to be heavenly minded. In the Holy Gospel, Matthew records the surprise of the women when the resurrected Christ appears to them.

CREED *1 Corinthians 15:17; Second Article of the Apostles' Creed*

P Paul writes, “If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.” Because of this, Easter morning delivers the joyous truth that Christ has been raised, and God has made us His people through our Baptism into Christ. Living together in trust and hope, we confess our faith in His work accomplished for us.

C I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

P What does this mean?

C I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from all eternity, and also true man, born of the virgin Mary, is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned person, purchased and won me from all sins, from death, and from the power of the devil; not with gold or silver, but with His holy, precious blood and with His innocent suffering and death, that I may be His own and live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness, just as He is risen from the dead, lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.
