

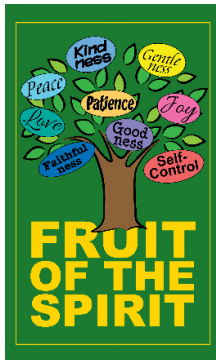

SERIES THEME: The Fruit of the Spirit

The services from The Baptism of Our Lord (January 8) through Transfiguration (February 26) are tied together by the theme “The Fruit of the Spirit” from Galatians 5:22–23. Each Sunday focuses on a different fruit.

THEME CELEBRATION “Faithfulness” *Deuteronomy 32:4; Proverbs 12:22*

From the very first books of the Bible and through all of Scripture, the faithfulness of God is expressed as being central to His divine character. In his song included in Deuteronomy, Moses rejoices in this attribute of God, “The Rock, His work is perfect, for all His ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is He.” God has shown faithfulness to His people from the very beginning of His dealing with them.

Proverbs says, “Those who act faithfully are His delight.” The faithfulness evidenced by God’s people is a reflection of His faithfulness to all generations. In the season of Epiphany, we can find opportunities to manifest some of this faithfulness.

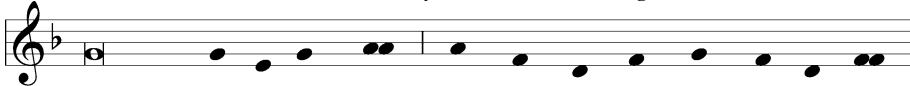

IN REGARD TO HOLY COMMUNION: According to Scripture, Holy Communion should be celebrated by those who are: **United in a common faith** (1 Cor. 10:16-17, 21-22; Rom. 16:17); **Repentant of sins** (1 Cor. 5:11, Matt. 18:17-18); **Able to examine their lives** (1 Cor. 11:27-29); and believe that in this precious meal they **receive the true body and blood of Jesus** given and shed for the forgiveness of their sins (Luke 22:19-22).

Since Scripture teaches that those people who do not fully understand the meaning of this meal eat and drink to their own harm (1Cor. 11:27-29), and because the Lord's Supper is the

supreme act of stating our unity in faith and doctrine, we would ask those people who are visiting with us to **please speak with our Pastor**, preferably prior to the day of worship, in order that we might fulfill our responsibility of properly instructing people in the right use of the precious Sacrament.

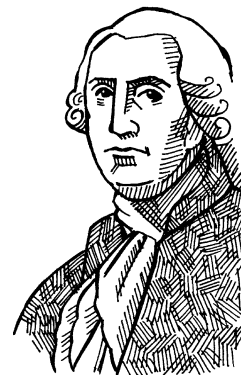
