

SERIES THEME: The Fruit of the Spirit

The services from The Baptism of Our Lord (January 8) through Transfiguration (February 26) are tied together by the theme "The Fruit of the Spirit" from Galatians 5:22–23. Each Sunday focuses on a different fruit.

THEME CELEBRATION "Patience" 1 Corinthians 13:4; Ephesians 4:1–2; 1 Timothy

"Love is patient and kind." As Paul wrote these words, he was in no way limiting them to bridal couples or married people. He was affirming that patience is an important fruit of the Spirit for everyone. In Ephesians, he directs his readers "to walk . . . with patience" as they live out their unity in Christ.

Paul sees exhibiting true patience as finding its source in Jesus. He writes to his young co-worker Timothy, "But I received mercy for this reason, that in me, as the foremost, Jesus Christ might display His perfect patience." In bearing the fruit of patience, we show forth a Christ like virtue.

BUILDING NEWS

Thank you for your continued gifts to our Building Fund – We thank you for your gifts last Sunday to the Building Fund of \$2,190.00. The gifts were designated as follows:

The Debt Retirement Account: \$2,090.00 The Building Account: \$100.00

Debt Retirement Challenge A generous family in our congregation offered to match all debt retirement gifts given though December up to \$10,000.00. You took on the challenge in a big way. A total of \$31,311.50 was given which then turned in to a total of \$41,311.50 with the family's match. As a result of the challenge, the balance of the Church Extension Fund Loan is now \$318,079.74. Through December 2016 we've made a total of 172 advance payments resulting in a savings of \$568,896.23 in interest!
