Unlike the "underground" churches of the past and yes, even present, our church with its stately appearance bears witness in our community of our faith in the Risen Christ, He who rose "out of the ground". May our faith in the one who rose "out of the ground" stir us to rise each morning to the love and service of each other and of God's Holy church.
